1. GENERAL INFORMATION, BASIC PRINCIPLES AND RULES

1.1. UHS Exam for International Students (Foreign Student Examination) –SBÜYÖS2019 for the quota for foreign and overseas students. This exam is carried out by University of Health Sciences. SBUYOS2019 will take place in exam centres (**Appendix 1**) in Turkey on 7 July 2019, Sunday, at 10.00 a.m. **SBUYOS time for online exam centres (Appendix 2) outside Turkey will be announced according to the local time of the country in which the exam takes place, at 10.00a.m.** This guide contains the regulations and procedures which must be followed by the students from abroad who wish to apply to University of Health Sciences (UHS) for the years **2019-2020**. SBUYOS document is valid for one academic year following the exam date.

1.2. All correspondence between our university and applicants must be in Turkish or English, using the Latin alphabet.

1.3. Applications will be made between 17 May-7 June 2019 by using the online application system on <https://basvuru.sbu.edu.tr>

1.4. Exam fee will be paid for the account of SBU Strategy Development Office by writing name-surname information in the explanation part of the debit slip within the application dates.

1.5. Applicants must upload the photo of your debit slip and your passport's ID page on the system.

1.6. Applicants must print out their entrance documents before the exam, and bring it with their passport or ID cards on the exam date.

1.7. Those who lose their entrance documents can login again and take its print out.

1.8. The results of UHS Foreign Student Examination (“SBÜYÖS2019”) are applicable only for students who wish to be rolled in an associate degree and/or undergraduate program at SBÜYÖS2019 results cannot be used for transfers and/or graduate programs.

1.9. Applicants that come to take SBUYOS2019 pay for their accommodation, residence permit, and living. Application fee that applicants pay may not be credited towards future examination dates. Applications of those who have not paid the contribution fee for expenditures will not be accepted. **Applicants who pay the application fee for SBUYÖS2019, but decide not to apply, or those whose applications are invalid, or those who do not or cannot take the interview, or those who are not allowed to sit the interview, or who fail the interview or who pay for any procedure that does not require payment cannot claim the right to be fund of the fees paid.**

1.10. UHS reserves the right to make any such changes in the regulations of the examination as deemed necessary, pursuant to the ruling so executive, legislative, and/or judicial bodies, and/or of the Council of Higher Education Council (“YÖK”), UHS Executive Board or the UHS Senate which may come into effect after the announcement of this guide. The procedure to be followed in such a case will be determined by UHS. Furthermore, any contingency not specifically covered in this Guide will likewise be dealt with by the UHS Senate.

1.11. SBUYÖS2019 Guide will not be published or distributed in paper form.

2. APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

SBUYÖS2019 exam applications or applications for international student quotas made with exam results and diploma grades specified in EK-2 are to be made from the following address <https://basvuru.sbu.edu.tr>. Applications made after the dead line will not be accepted.

After the placement made by the University, it is obligatory to meet the requirements mentioned in article 2.1 before registration.

Applicants who do not submit the required documents during registration will not be admitted.

2.1. Provided that the candidates are in the last year of their secondary education or they are in the status of a graduate;

a) Application of Foreign nationals,

b) Application of individuals despite having Turkish citizenship by birth, obtained authorization to

leave citizenship from the Ministry of Interior Affairs and their children who are recorded in the Turkish citizenship renunciation document but who are not adult and who certify that they have the document which according to Turkish Citizenship Law allows them the Exercise of the (Citizenship) Rights(According to article 7 of the law 5901Turkish Citizenship Law, children born to Turkish parents in a marital union, in Turkey or abroad are Turkish citizens. Applicants considering benefitting of the abroad quotas should investigate the Turkish Citizenship Law),

c) Individuals who obtained Turkish Republic citizenship as a second citizenship/Individuals with dual nationality,

d) I. Application of individuals who completed the last three years of secondary education abroad besides TRNC (Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus) (including individuals who completed the whole secondary education (high school) abroad besides TRNC at schools opened with authorization of the Ministry of Education of Turkey),

II. Application of individuals, with Turkish nationality, who completed their secondary education in a foreign country besides Cyprus before 01.02.2013 (including those who completed their secondary education (high school) in a foreign country other than Cyprus, in schools opened with authorization of the Ministry of education of Turkey),

e) Application of individuals with TRNC nationality who live in TRNC, who have completed their secondary education in TRNC and who obtained GCEAL exam results and individuals who got registered to other foreign colleges and high schools between 2005-2010 and obtained or will obtain GCEAL exam results, **will be accepted.**

2.2. Application of individuals;

a) who have Turkish citizenship (except for those who completed secondary education (high school) in a foreign country other than TRNC,

b) who have citizenship of Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (except for those who have completed secondary education (high school) in TRNC high schools and who have GCE AL results and who have enrolled and studied in colleges and high schools in other countries between 2005-2010 and who have or will have GCE AL exam results),

c) who have, by birth, Turkish citizenship which is defined in section "b" (except those that confirm with the requirements of Article 2.1 section "d" and "e");

d) who have dual citizenship which one of them is TRNC citizenship (those who completed the entire secondary education (high school) in TRNC schools with GCEAL results and those who enrolled and studied in colleges and high schools in foreign countries between 2005-2010 and who have or will have GCEAL results)

e) Who being of Turkish nationality Turkish studied high school in the embassies in Turkey and who enrolled in foreign high schools in Turkey or has Turkish citizenship at birth as the first nationality as defined in section "b", Article 2.1,

f) got dismissed from a higher education institution due to a disciplinary offense in Turkey, or who were found guilty of cheating while attending examinations conducted by ÖSYM or ÜYÖS in previous years,

g) who acted against the Republic of Turkey or got denationalized from Turkish citizenship as a sanction, **will not be accepted.**

3. APPLICATION PROCEDURES

3.1. Applicants must fill in the application form online at <https://basvuru.sbu.edu.tr> within the application period.

3.2. Applicants will bear full responsibility for errors entered into the application form. Information areas related to the identity of the applicant must be entered without any abbreviations and without changing the credentials of the passport.

3.3. E-mail address requested in the application form, should belong to the applicant and each applicant should use only one E-mail address. Other applicants can't use this address for correspondence/process.

3.4. If the high school diploma is not in Turkish or English, then version of the diploma should be translated in Turkish by a Sworn Translation Office and uploaded to the system. Applicants who have not received their diploma at the time of application, will submit a formal certificate (temporary graduation certificate), which shows their due graduation date and their expected graduation grades.

3.5. The applications of individuals who do not upload the exam result certificate /the diploma in accordance with the acceptance criteria specified in table **Appendix-3** during the online application process will not be taken into consideration. Final registration of the applicant will be done with the originals of the documents uploaded to the system during the online application.

3.6. The YÖS result document necessary for the application should be uploaded to the system. Only exams in Annex 3 are accepted. Applicants with more than one YÖS result document should only upload one of the results to the system. No application is valid with other exam results than the ones specified. In case the applicants cannot load the YÖS result due to technical reasons, they will be assisted with the relevant application, if they present themselves at the Bureau Of Students' Affairs in person before the end of the application period.

3.7. Applicant's picture should be transferred to the electronic environment in the relevant area on the application form. Since this photograph will take place on the Exam Entrance Document and Exam Result Document, it should be taken from the front and within the last six months, so that the candidate can be easily recognized. There should not be any changes that would influence the recognition of the applicant on this photograph. It should be kept in mind that if the Hall Chair has difficulty in identifying the applicant due to the photograph, the applicant will not be allowed to the exam hall.

3.8. The eligibility of applications is evaluated by the International Student Coordination Office in accordance with the SBÜYÖS2019 Directive and the admission criteria in Annex-3.

Payment of the Application Fee

3.9. The applicants who will apply to SBÜYÖS2019 will pay the application fee with the following information within the application period.

Please do not forget to write this description information during payment!

3.10. After paying the application fee, upload the digital format of transfer receipt which shows that the examination fee has been deposited in the relevant field.

3.11. Applicants can deposit the required application fee from any branch of the bank in Turkey. Applicants outside Turkey can deposit the required application fee from a correspondent bank or any other internationally active bank (SWIFT Code: TVBATR2AXXX).

3.12. Applicants who are to deposit the application fee, from within or outside Turkey, should be careful about the following points:

- Applicants are considered to have paid the application fee for expenditures only after the funds have been transferred and credited to SBÜ's account.

- Personal checks, money orders, travelers' checks, postal orders, bank notes or any other form of money transfer are not acceptable; bank checks, postal orders or money enclosed in an envelope should not be sent by post.

- The processing fee that may be charged by the bank for the service of depositing the application is not included in the application fee.

- The application will be invalid unless the application fee has been paid.

- Applicants should check the information on the confirmation slip to make sure it is accurate before leaving the bank. Any mistakes should be corrected immediately.

4. CALL FOR EXAM

4.1. The applications of the candidates are examined by the SBU. In this examination, it is determined whether the information is complete and whether the application fee is in the bank account. Candidates whose applications are accepted at the end of the examination of application are required to enter the online application system and take the printout of the Exam Entrance Document and keep them with the exam. The Exam Entrance

Document will indicate the building and the room where the candidate will take the exam.

4.2. Candidates must complete entry and exit clearance procedures in accordance with the rules of their country during the SBUYÖS process. The SBU does not take responsibility for the candidates' permission to take the exam or to issue a passport for demand does not have any means to provide them.

5. SBUYÖS2019 EXAM

5.1. SBUYÖS2019 will be held on July 7, 2019 Sunday morning at 10:00 local time in Turkey at exam centers located in Turkey (Appendix 1). Also, the exam will be held at 10:00 local time of the country at exam centers out of Turkey (**Appendix 2**).

5.2. Candidates are required to take the SBUYÖS2019 Exam Entrance Document, Passport and/or IDs with them.

5.3. Candidates are strictly forbidden to take the exam with their mobile phone and calculator.

5.4. Candidates will be taken to the examination hall after 1 (one) hour before the start of the exam. The exam will be held as a single session. It is very important for the candidates to come to the building at least one hour before the exam.

5.5. The SBUYÖS2019 exam consists of 80 questions of abstract thinking, mathematics, physics, chemistry and biology.

5.6. SBUYÖS2019 Exam duration is 150 minutes.

5.7. All questions in the question booklet are multiple choice type questions. Five different options are given for each question, only one of them is the correct answer. When these tests are scored, one fourth of the number of incorrect answers will be deducted from the number of correct answers and the remaining number will be the raw score of the candidate.

5.8. The answers must be marked on the answer paper. The answers marked on the question booklet are not valid.

5.9. During the examination, the candidates' speech and copying is against the rules of the examination. If this is proven by any means, the exams of the candidates will be considered invalid.

5.10. At the end of the exam, each candidate will submit the question booklet and answer paper to the officers.

5.11. The answer papers of the candidates whose exams are considered invalid will not be taken into consideration because they do not comply with the examination rules or have not submitted the required documents at the end of the examination. Also, documents of exam results for these candidates will not be prepared.

6. SCIENCE EXAM AND INTERVIEW FOR CANDIDATES WHO HAVE NOT TAKEN SBUYÖS 2019 EXAM

6.1. The science exam will consist of 40 questions including Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

6.2. Duration of science exam is 75 minutes

6.3. All the questions in science exam booklet are multiple choice questions. Five different choices are given for each question, only one of them is the correct answer. When these tests are scored, one fourth of the number of incorrect answers will be deducted from the number of correct answers and the remaining number will be the raw score of the candidate.

6.4. The answers must be marked on the answer paper. The answers marked on the question booklet are not valid.

6.5. During the science examination, the candidates' speech and copying is against the rules of the examination. If this is proven by any means, the exams of the candidates will be considered invalid.

6.6. At the end of the science exam, each candidate will submit the question booklet and answer paper to the officers.

6.7. The answer papers of the candidates whose science exams are considered invalid will not be taken into consideration because they do not comply with the examination rules or have not submitted the required documents at the end of the examination. Also, documents of exam results for these candidates will not be prepared.

6.8. Candidates providing application requirements with 40 points or more from the science exam are announced to be invited for the interview in line with success ranking. Number of students to be interviewed

is up to 3 (three) times more than the quota announced by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK).

6.9. Candidate interview sare conducted at the centers in Turkey and abroad, which is determined by the university.

6.10. Applicants will be able to access the science examination and admission document through the application system.

7. EVALUATION OF SBÜYÖS2019 APPLICATION RESULTS

7.1. Number of correct and wrong answers given by the applicants to the questions in SBÜYÖS 2019 exam will be counted. The raw score will be determined by deducting one fourth of number of wrong answers from the number of correct answers. The raw score will be converted to hundreds (100) system and announced.

7.2. Candidates who have applied in accordance with the acceptance criteria in Appendix -3, will enter the science exam and interview prepared by the University. Candidates will have access to pre-evaluation results regarding being eligible for science exam and interview on <https://basvuru.sbu.edu.tr> website on the dates stated in the Schedule.

8. ANNOUNCEMENT OF RESULTS OF SBÜYÖS2019 EXAM, SCIENCE EXAM AND INTERVIEW

8.1. Applicants will be able to learn SBÜYÖS2019 exam results and science exam and interview results online on <https://basvuru.sbu.edu.tr>

8.2. Examination result document is going to be required during final registration for students from abroad or foreign students quotas.

9. SBÜYÖS2019 BASE POINT

Acceptance to university's departments will be made according to base points and departments' base points will be announced on <https://basvuru.sbu.edu.tr> during preference stage.

10. EVALUATION

10.1 In line with the criteria accepted by our university (**Appendix-3**) candidates are evaluated according to their SBÜYÖS2019 exam result, national/international exam results, high school graduation grades (Results except SBÜYÖS, SAT II and ACT and results of evaluation that will be made by the applicants' science exam and interview results (**Appendix-5**)). In the case where there is an equality, the students' date of birth will be taken into account, whereby the younger candidate will be accepted.

10.2. Evaluation of the applications and placement of the applicants are completely under the authority of UHS. UHS is free to fill or not to fill the vacant quotas. Having fulfilled the application conditions does not mean that the applicant has been accepted for placement.

10.3. Applicants will be able to find the evaluation results on <https://basvuru.sbu.edu.tr>

11. SBÜYÖS2019 QUOTAS

The final quotas will be announced after the approval of the Council of Higher Education.

12. PROCEDURES FOR PROGRAM PREFERENCE AND PLACEMENT

12.1. Applicants may choose a maximum of 2 (two) programs of their preference. The applicant's first choice will be given priority during placement.

12.2. In the placement process, 20% country barrier will be applied to the total quota of each program. If the quota has not been filled up, the university may place students by considering the number of the countries and other related issues.

12.3. Applicants will be placed in only one program.

12.4. The placement results of the applicants will be announced on the Application System of our university on the dates indicated on the academic calendar. Applicants will learn their placement results using their usernames and passwords.

12.5. Applicants can reach their acceptance documents through the Application system.

12.6. Vacant quotas are evaluated according to the decision of UHS Senate.

13. REGISTRATION

13.1. Each applicant accepted in a UHS program, regardless of his/her level in Turkish, must comply with the regulations of UHS and submit the required documents at the beginning of the academic year 2019-2020, and register within the stated registration dates. Where necessary, registration can be done with a power of attorney.

13.2. With the acceptance letter by UHS, applicants must obtain the education visa from embassies or consulates of the Republic of Turkey abroad.

13.3. Applicants who are in Turkey need to get a residence permit from the Provincial Police Headquarters instead of an education visa.

13.4. Registration is made every year at the place and time announced by the Department of Student Affairs. Applicants who are not able to complete their registration in the given time interval lose their rights to register. **Necessary documents for registration:**

13.5. The “Equivalency Document” obtained from the Turkish Embassy, Turkish Consulate or Provincial National Education Directorates, that indicates the applicant’s high school certificate is equivalent to the Turkish high schools.

13.6. The original of the high school certificate or diploma, and its notarized Turkish translation or Turkish translation approved by the Turkish Embassy or the Turkish Consulate abroad. (No need for translation if it is in English).

13.7. Print outs of international exam results accepted in **Appendix-3** and exam result document of UHS YÖS exam.

13.8. The notary or Turkish external representor certified copy of Passport pages with identification information of the student and passport validation date and its Turkish translation. (No need for translation if it is in English)

13.9. The document of residency (It has to be given within one month after registration).

13.10. The bank receipt that indicates the paid tuition fee.

13.11. Financial assurance declaration with signature, showing that the applicant has the financial assurance to cover his/her higher education and living in our country. (This form will be obtained from our university.)

13.12. Minimum 60 or more days valid visa, visa exemption or residence permit

13.13. Conditions related to language proficiency level are as follows:

a) Applicants for Turkish programs in Turkish

1) Must get a minimum of 75 points at the Turkish Proficiency Exam of University of Health Sciences. in the case that the exam takes place.

2) Must have a degree on their Turkish proficiency document from Turkish language Education Research and Application Center (TÖMER) corresponding to minimum of 75 points.

3) They can start their education if they have a degree corresponding to minimum 75 points or more according to Turkish Proficiency document granted by Yunus Emre Institute.

4) The Turkish proficiency level of the registered students, who do not have a Turkish proficiency certificate will be determined according to the results of the Turkish Proficiency exam administered by the Department of Turkish Language in our university. If one cannot get 75 points or over from this exam, he/she must attend the one-year Preparatory Turkish Program. The associate degree students must certify their Turkish Proficiency by C1 level certificate at the beginning of fourth semester the latest, and the undergraduate degree students must certify their Turkish Proficiency by C1 level certificate at the beginning of fifth semester the latest. If students do not complete their Turkish proficiency level at the end of this period, they get dismissed.

b) Candidates who apply for programs in English (30%); Turkish Proficiency:

In case of

1) getting at least 75 points from the Turkish Proficiency Exam of the University of Health Sciences when conducted

2) having a letter grade which is at least 75 points and above in Turkish language proficiency certificate of Turkish Language Teaching Research and Application Centers of Universities

3) having a letter grade which is at least 75 points and above in Turkish language proficiency certificate of Yunus Emre Institute, **can start their education.**

The Turkish language proficiency level of the registered students, who do not have a Turkish language proficiency certificate, will be determined according to the results of the Turkish Proficiency exam to be administered by the Department of Turkish Language in our university. If students cannot get 75 points and over from this exam, they must attend the one-year preparatory Turkish program. The students who are registered in associate degree programs are required to bring a Turkish Proficiency Certificate at C1 level at the beginning of the fourth semester at the latest. The students who are registered in undergraduate programs have to bring a Turkish Proficiency Certificate at C1 level at the beginning of the fifth semester at the latest. If students do not complete their Turkish proficiency level at the end of this period, they get dismissed.

English Preparatory Program:

1) In accordance with the provisions of the "Regulation on Foreign Language Teaching in Higher Education Institutions and the Principles to be Followed in Foreign Language Teaching", one-year compulsory English Preparatory Program is applied. At the end of the program, students who pass the English Proficiency Exam are enrolled directly in the first year. English Preparatory Program is not included in the duration of the program.

2) In order to be exempted from the English Preparatory Program, the students need to:

a. certify that they have obtained the score determined by our university from the national foreign language exams accepted by the Council of Higher Education and equivalence of internationally accepted foreign language exams

b. certify that they have completed their secondary education (at least the last three years) in a native-speaking country of English, at an institution the citizens of the specific country attend

c. be successful at the English Proficiency Exam to be administered by our university at the beginning of the academic year.

3) The maximum length of the preparatory program is two years. According to the regulations of the program that they are registered, students who are required to take English Proficiency must certify their language proficiency by the end of two years at most, and then they start their education at the programs that they are registered. Despite the fact that students attend the compulsory preparatory class of the programs that they are placed in, those who cannot complete the preparatory class successfully in two years are dismissed.

13.14. Six passport photographs 4,5 x 6 cm. (taken within the last six months, frontline, where the candidate must be easily recognizable),

13.15. The health board report indicating the applicant's health condition,

13.16. Certificate of identity register copy from those, holding dual-citizenship, who hold citizenship of other countries by birth and have gained the citizenship of The Republic of Turkey

13.17. Foreign students who are registered in the university can have a general health insurance by paying a general health prim if they apply in three months from the date of first registration.

13.18. The application of a candidate is rejected if the candidate provides misinformation, and presents false, incomplete and incorrect documents in the processes of application, placement and registration. If these applicants are registered at the University, their registrations are cancelled regardless of the period of study. The necessary legal proceedings are initiated for those whose activities constitute crime.

14. TUITION FEE

The tuition fee for students from abroad and foreign national students for 2019-2020 Academic Year will be decided annually by our university's board of directors on the basis of the "Decision on the Determination of the Contribution Margins and Tuition Fees for the Higher Education Institutions Current Service Costs being taken as Student Contribution" that was published by the Council of Ministers (Appendix-4)
